Topic:

This week, we will be introducing the children to our new topic, Superheroes! They will have the opportunity to play in our Superhero Headquarters, paint superhero pictures, read and write superhero stories.

Maths:

In maths this week, we will be looking at size. We will be comparing the size of various objects and using the language tall, taller, tallest, long, longer, longest, short, shorter, shortest.

English:

In English this week, we will be reading the story of 'The Gingerbread Man'. We will look at the setting and the characters in the story and sequence events.

The children will have the opportunity to re-enact the story using finger puppets and props.

Homework:

Tricky words homework will be given out on Friday.

Please read the list of games and activities suggested to help learn them. We have included a laminated sheet of tricky word cards. There are two sets of tricky word cards on the laminated sheet, one for you and one for your child. Please cut out the cards and play the games suggested. You can keep these cards at home. We recommend you play these games on a regular basis (1 - 2 times per week) to help your child's progression in reading.
