### Messages:

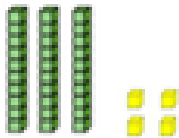

### Maths:

This week, we will revisit place value. The children will count in 5s, solve missing number problems and partition two digit numbers into tens and ones.

$$34 = 30 + 4$$



### English:

In English this week, the children will focus on basic skills. They will practise writing sentences with perfect punctuation. Later in the week, they will learn about singular and plural nouns and the suffix – un.

### Topic and science:

We will begin a new topic this week, *seas and oceans*. We will discuss what the children already know and what they would like to find out. Their English work will be based on this topic as they will write about life under the sea.

In science, we will talk about the differences between winter and spring.
