

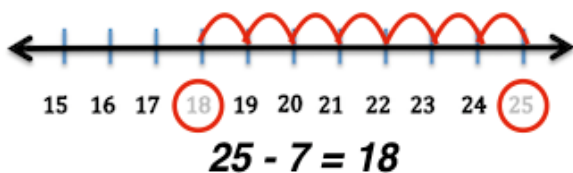
Year 1 Weekly update: 9th May 2018

Messages:

On Friday 11th May, Year 1 have a class assembly about Buddhism. We would love to see you there. Please arrive at school by 2.25pm to meet a member of staff who will take you to the assembly.

Maths:

This week, the children will be continuing to work on addition and subtraction. We will focus on using mental methods to add and subtract smaller amounts. They will also use number lines to find the answer to larger addition and subtraction word problems.



English:

English is linked to R.E. this week, as the children will be learning about Wesak and Buddhism in preparation for their assembly. They will use Talk For Writing to learn a Buddhist story about a brave monkey king. They will also learn about the different ways Buddhists celebrate Wesak and discuss similarities with other religious celebrations.

Topic and science:

There will be no topic lessons this week due to the bank holiday.

In science, we will discuss signs of spring and summer. The children will draw a new sketch of the tree in the playground that they sketched during the autumn and winter months.
