Maths:

This week, we will revise number and place value. The children will be using numicon to support with teen numbers. They will also practise using tens frames and counters to partition numbers into tens and ones.

English:

The children will be studying *Floppy's Bath*. They will focus on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in their writing. They will also focus on writing sentences and reviewing them to check that they make sense.

Topic and science:

We will be starting a new topic, *North America*. The children will be learning about some important historical figures, the geography of this continent and the history of Native Americans.

In science, the children will be learning about materials. The children will investigate different materials and discuss what they are made of.
