



**Just a reminder:**

Reading

It is so important that you read every night with your child and sign their reading diary to show this. Your child has **two reading books** sent home with them every week. Please **keep them in their bag** so that they can get them out during the day. If children do not bring in their books, they cannot change them for new ones.

**Messages:**

PE is on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please ensure that your child has a PE kit at school on these days. A Duncombe PE kit is a white t-shirt, black or navy shorts/leggings and trainers. Please bring it into school and expect your child to leave it here for the term.

**Maths:**

This week we are learning about time. We will be comparing different measures of time and learning how to tell the time using an analogue clock. Try to practise this at home with your child. It is not just a useful way to learn to count in 5s, it is an important life skill!

**Phonics / Spellings:**

The spelling pattern that your child will be learning this week is the sound /j/ spelt 'g' before e, i and y AND the sound /j/ spelt 'j' before a, o and u.

Please ensure your child practices the spelling list in the homework book and writes 3 sentences.

**English:**

This week we will be reading 'Into the woods' by Anthony Browne. We will be making predictions using evidence in the text. We will also be comparing this text with other Traditional Tales that we have read, discussing similarities and differences.

**Topic:**

This week we will be discussing our trip to the Tower of London.

**Science:**

This week we will be thinking about hygiene and why it is important to keep clean. We will be talking about the different ways we can keep ourselves clean.

**Homework:**

You **must** complete the **maths and spellings homework**. For extra points, there are 3 to 4 choices each week of Topic homework that you can pick from to complete.
