Maths:

This week we will be working on the children's fluency and efficiency with number. Firstly, we will be looking at how we can use knowledge of number bonds to 10 to add efficiently. We will move on to using bead strings to help us find number bonds to 100. We will also be looking at how to double and halve 2-digit numbers, using partitioning to help us.

Phonics / Spellings:

This week your child will be learning the months of the year.

Your child needs to copy out each spelling using look, cover, write, check. You may find it useful to have a practice spelling test!

Your child needs to write 3 sentences using as many of the words as they can.

English:

This week the children will be reading 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna which is about refugees on a journey to find a new home. We will be comparing this text to 'Leaf' by Sandra Deickman which is about a bear that finds himself in a strange place and wants to travel home. The children will have the opportunity to respond to these texts through discussions, drama and art work.

Topic:

This week we will be learning about the Brazilian artist Romero Britto. The children will be creating colourful art work in his original style.
