

### Messages:

### Maths:

This week we will continue looking at how to double and halve 2-digit numbers, using partitioning to help us. We will also be looking at using our knowledge of doubles to add efficiently. Lastly, we will be revising addition and subtraction working with larger numbers.

### Phonics / Spellings:

This week your child will be learning the months of the year and time words.

Your child needs to copy out each spelling using look, cover, write, check. You may find it useful to have a practice spelling test!

Your child needs to write 3 sentences using as many of the words as they can.

### English:

This week the children will be reading 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna which is about refugees on a journey to find a new home. We will be comparing this text to 'Leaf' by Sandra Deickman which is about a bear that finds himself in a strange place and wants to travel home. The children will have the opportunity to respond to these texts through discussions, drama and art work.
