

Messages:

Next Tuesday (20th March 2018) we will be visiting the Highgate Hill Murugan Temple in the morning, to learn more about the Hindu faith and Hindu people in our community.

Maths:

This week we are looking at how to find fractions of amounts, e.g. $\frac{1}{2}$ of 14, $\frac{1}{4}$ of 8. The children are drawing pictures to help them to work it out.

We are also looking at fractions and matching them to representations to show that we understand how the denominator shows how many parts the number is divided into.

Phonics / Spellings:

This week your child will be learning to spell words where there is a stressed /er/ spelt with 'or' after w and the sound /or/ spelt 'ar' after w.

Please ensure your child practices the spelling list in the homework book. Write three sentences using the words and make sure your child knows what they mean.

English:

This week we are reading the story, The Snail and the Whale and writing a book review about it.

We will be recalling the different parts of the story and expressing our opinions about the different parts of the book.

Can your child tell you the story at home?

Topic:

This week in Topic we wrote news reports about the Great Fire of London. Could you discuss newspapers at home? What do you read?

Science:

We will be learning about what animals live in the different layers of the rainforest.
