Messages:

Welcome back!

This week we are starting swimming. Please ensure your child has their swimming kit. All afternoon lessons will not take place for the next two weeks as we all learn to swim!

Maths:

In maths we are learning about fractions. We are looking at shapes and fractions of amounts. We are also learning about tenths and decimals for the first time – and converting between decimals and tenths.
