

**Messages:**

**Maths:**

In maths this week we are looking at money. We will be giving change, finding different ways to make an amount and becoming familiar with our coins.

**English:**

We are continuing our work on the story of Rama and Sita.

We will be learning to use direct speech and the present perfect form of verbs.

**Science:**

In science we are continuing to keep our table plants alive. Each table has got a flowering plant which they are going to try and nurture and grow. We are continuing with an experiment where we have put some plants in the dark and some we are not watering to see what effect that will have on the plants. We are also trying to grow some different beans.

**Topic:**

We continue our topic by moving into the Bronze Age. We will be learning about how life changed for these early humans. We are also zooming through time to the Neolithic Age.

**Homework:**
