

## Year 6 Weekly Update: 17th September, 2018

## Maths:

Children have been given homework which matches their lesson, it is better if they wait to do maths homework until the weekend, so you know they have covered the areas of maths in their homework.

Children will continue to focus on place value next week. They will practise rounding whole numbers and decimals and they will be working on their test technique.

**English:** Children will continue to learn about the Year 6 writing statements they must include in all their written work. This week we are focusing on: complex sentences, how to add detail and precision to our writing and general punctuation rules.

**SPaG:** children will be learning to categorise words into the correct word class and learning how to use words as nouns, verbs or adjectives.

Please continue to ensure your child is spending 30 minutes reading each night.

**Spellings:** Check which spelling list your child should practise and find time to help them at home.
