Messages:

Maths:

Katija:

This week, we will be completing a number of lessons based on different topics. These will include: algebra, fractions including decimals and percentages, money problems, properties of number, rounding, sequences and angles.

Eugene:

Children will continue to learn about area and perimeter including finding missing lengths and area of complex shapes. We will complete SATs style questions and apply the knowledge we have gained.

Spellings:

This half term, we would like children to choose the spellings they want to practise themselves so that their homework is addressing their specific needs. They will choose them from the Year 5 and 6 spelling list or the Year 6 spelling patterns. They will then be tested on these words by a partner on a Monday afternoon. This is instead of learning a perfect paragraph. We hope this means they will be able to challenge themselves!

English:

We are starting the new class novel 'Street Child'. This week, there will be an introduction to the historical setting as well as a discussion about Victorian London. Children will continue onto completing comprehension questions based on the chapters read out in class.


SPaG: Children will have the opportunity to complete self-directed SPaG revision working in small groups.

Topic:

Our topic is linked to the class novel 'Street Child'. Children will start to look at the literature and make links to the time and history it was set in. Children's lives in Victorian times will also be studied and the differences will be compared to children's own lives.

Science: Science will be replaced with revision lessons in preparation for SATs.

Homework: Children now need to complete compulsory homework from the reading comprehension book and the maths workbook. In addition, the spelling, perfect paragraph and weekly grammar and punctuation worksheet will be in homework books. Topic and science homework will also be provided but these are optional. Homework is due on **Monday**. New homework is sent home by **Tuesday**.
