We want all our children to enjoy reading. It would be great if you could encourage your child to sing songs and read stories together at home as this supports our young people with many things like... speech, listening skills, their imagination, have a love of stories and much more.

Here is some information on why it's so importance to read stories and sing songs with our young children.

Repetition of rhymes and stories is good for the brain, teaching how language works and building memory capabilities. Nursery rhymes help develop inferencing skills, both with encountering new words and in reading comprehension. Because these verses are made up of patterns, they are easy first memorisation pieces.

Toddlers can develop their oral skills as they say rhymes. Rhyming books help children begin to predict what is coming or predict what word will end the sentence. These predictive skills are also important pre-reading skills. Plus, rhymes are fun!


We will be starting our Going home Library book box. So please ensure you bring in your child's book bag.


Our story for the next 2 weeks is...
