<b>Year 2</b>	Architect, plan, dots, lines, hatching, cross, hatching, tones, detail, outline , smudging, blending, scumbling, colour wheel, colour, spectrums, dyes, effects, textured clean printed image, mimic print, print, press roll, rub, stamp, weaving
<b>Year 1</b>	Artist, idea, line, shape, sketch, primary colours, secondary colours, colour mixing, darker, lighter, pattern, materials, repeating
