

Duncombe Primary School data 2020- 2021

Due to the pandemic, there were no formal assessments during the academic year 2020-2021. However, at Duncombe we recognise that assessment plays an important part in improving the standards of teaching and learning across the school. Our community was badly affected by the pandemic but we know that high quality teaching and learning will ensure that children are able to overcome the adversity they have faced.

For this reason we assessed where children's gaps were when they returned to school after learning remotely and then addressed those gaps with targeted teaching. We assessed the children again at the end of the year to measure the progress they had made. We moderated core subjects across the school to quality assure our assessments and used standardised assessment papers to ensure assessments were accurate.
