

Duncombe Primary School data 2021- 2022



Our data highlights

- 79% of Y1 children passed the phonics screening check (25% increase from 2019).
- 71% achieved the expected level or higher in reading and maths at the end of KS1 (13% increase from 2019).
- 82% of children achieved the expected level in reading at the end of KS2 and 25% achieved the greater depth level. Our highest ever reading attainment in KS2.

KS2 attainment 2022

These statistics cover the attainment of year 6 pupils who took assessments in summer 2022. These pupils experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic, particularly at the end of year 4 and in year 5.

98% of children in Y4 took the MTC. One child was dis-applied due to being well below the expected level (SEN).
