

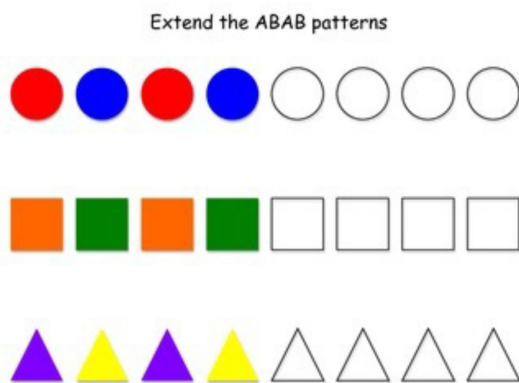
Dear Parents/Carers,

"All the better to see you with."

Story vocabulary will include: Forest, house, basket, Little Red Riding Hood, food, wolf, grandmother, granny, big ears, hear, big eyes, see, big teeth, eat, woodcutter, bed.
