Re: Video performances 2020-2021

Dear parents/carers,

Sadly, we are unable to have families into school this term and for the foreseeable months to celebrate events that your children are taking part in. Where possible we would still like to share things with you via videos on Duncombe's You Tube channel. Doing this involves making a recording of the children performing, uploading it to our You Tube channel, but as a private video that can only be viewed by those with the specific link. For your child to be in these videos this academic year, we need your consent and your assurance that you will only share the link with family members.

Over the next week or so, we will be asking you to sign your consent for this. If we do not have this, your child will be asked not to participate in any recorded performances, such as singing assemblies or nativity performances.

You can withdraw your consent once given, at any time, or for specific performances. This must be done in writing.

There are two ways that you can give consent or not;

- 1- By returning the completed form at the bottom of this letter.
- 2- By signing a class consent form (staff will have these in the playground after school to ensure everyone has responded, whether consenting or not)
