



Year 3 Weekly update:

Messages: Well done year 3 for a fantastic first week back.

On Thursday the children will be taking part in the Garden Classroom Project. Please ask your children about the experience.

Maths:

We will be learning about number. The children will be learning about 2 and 3 digit numbers and how to represent them using different equipment. They will revise odd and even numbers and they will learn about the value of a number.

The children must practise timetables at home. You can use Timetable Rock stars to help them.

Phonics / Spellings:

The children will be starting phonics groups and whole class guided reading. In the whole class guided reading group, the children will be practising fluency and learning how to check the text makes sense. We will also be making predictions based on what we have read so far.
Please remember to read with your child every night.

English:

In English, we have been focusing on writing a sentence with a capital letter and a full stop. Some children have been trying to include an exclamation mark or a questions mark.
We will be starting our new text called Traction Man. The children will be looking at different story settings and writing descriptions using adjectives.

Topic:

The children will be taking part in the Garden Classroom Project.

We will go to the local park and learn about the environment and how they can help improve it.

They will learn about the space they have access to in the local area.

Homework:

The children will be given spellings to practise at home.
Maths homework will be done using Mathletics. They will be given their user name and password on Monday. The work will match what the children have been learning about in class.
