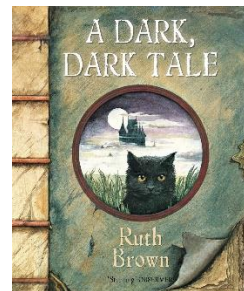
Rhyme of the week:
