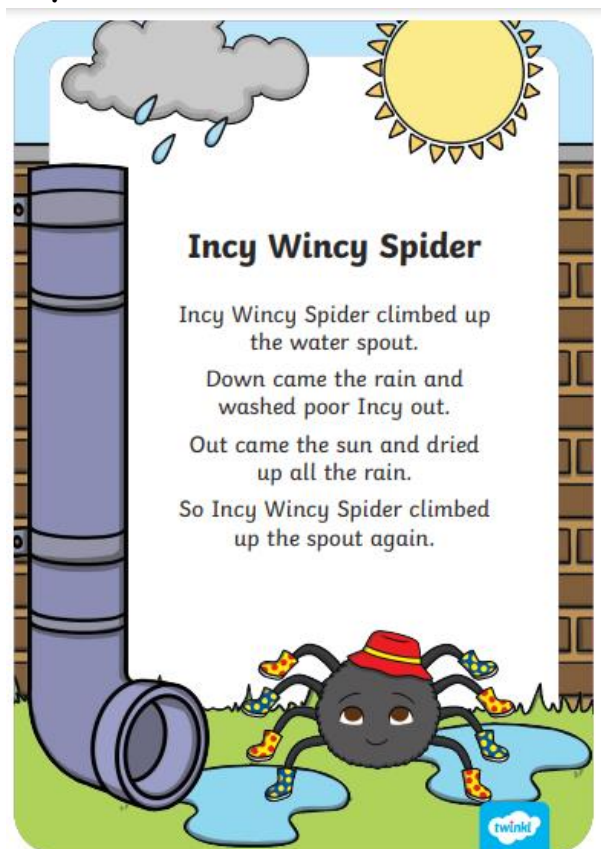
Messages:

We would love to start to celebrate things that your child has been busy doing after school or at the weekend with their family and friends through 'Show and Tell'.

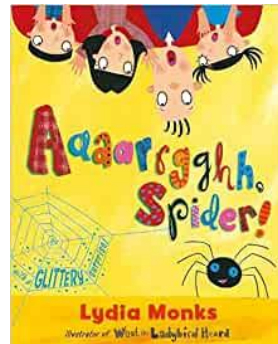
