(Say as a rhyme or make up your own tune.)

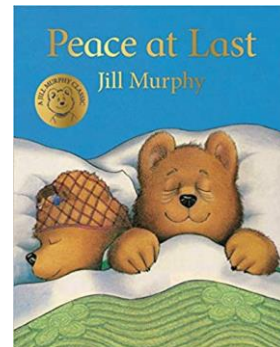
Teddy bear, teddy bear, turn around.
