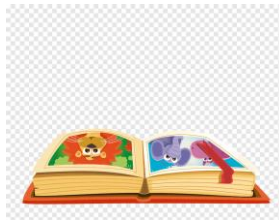

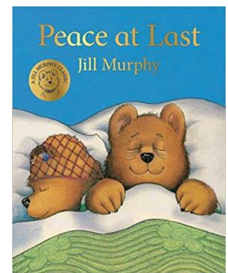
Home Reading
