School will finish early on Friday therefore there will be no afternoon session. Afternoon children will finish school on Thursday.

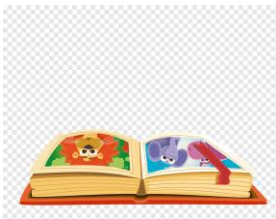
