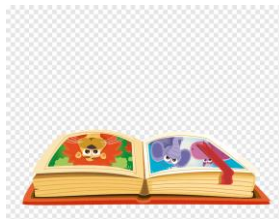

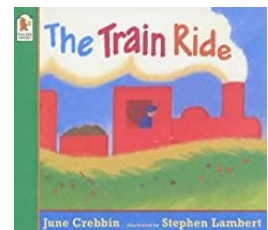
Home Reading

Literacy

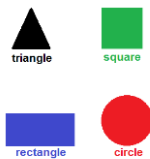
Over the next two weeks we will look at the story 'The Train Ride' by June Crebbin. Ask your child about the story we have been reading in school. Can they retell you the story at home?
