Messages:

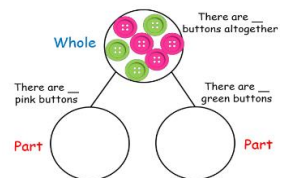
- PE will be on **Mondays** and **Thursdays** this term.

Maths:

English:

In English this week we will continue to look at the book 'Oi Frog'. The children will continue to look at rhyming words and then write their own sentence. The children will be focussing on writing capital letters, full stops and using their finger space.

Science:

Our topic in science will be 'Seasonal Changes.' We will be looking at evergreen and deciduous trees and recording the changes that happen to the trees throughout the seasons.

Topic:

Our topic this term in Yr 1 is all 'Me and my memories'. The children will start to become familiar with where they live and what is in their local area, they will also be learning all about Dick Whittington as he is connected to our area.
