

Messages:

We have had such a great week! The children took part in a Fire Safety online workshop. This included all the different ways we can be safe if there is a fire in the house. *Can your child tell you the safety measures they have to take if this happens?*

Just a reminder:

Reading: It is so important that you read every night with your child and sign their reading diary to show this. Your child has two reading books sent home with them every week. Please keep them in their bag so that they can get them out during the day. Reading books are changed when your child's books are in their bag and once they have read with an adult at school.

English:

At the end of the week we will be reading the story 'Into the Forest' by Anthony Brown. We will be discussing different traits of traditional tales and innovating our own.

We will also be learning about the four different sentence types which are statements, commands, exclamations and questions.

Maths:

This week we will be looking at partitioning whole and part numbers from 10 – 20. We will also be looking at number bonds to 20.

Phonics and spellings:

Children have been put into groups according to their phonic knowledge. They are given phonics books to bring home to practice with. Please make sure these books are always in their bag.

Topic:

During Topic, we will be looking at who the 'First Monarch' of England was. Can your child tell you who the Queen of England is now?

Science:

We are going to be learning about the importance of hygiene for our bodies. We will be looking at how to tackle germs and to stay healthy.
