

Reading:

It is crucial that you read every night with your child. It is amazing to see the progress in the children's reading when they are read every day at home. You can sign their reading diary, or the child can sign it themselves. Reading books are changed when your child's books are in their bag and once they have read with an adult at school.

Homework:

Homework will be **sent home on Fridays** and must be **returned by Thursday**. **Please ensure your child brings their homework book to school** otherwise they may not receive the following week's homework.

Messages:

Children should bring in water bottles to school, please label them so they don't get lost. Please make sure your child's jumper is labelled.

Maths:

This week in maths we will be subtraction.
Your children should be practicing adding multiples of ten to a two-digit number. E.g. $42 - 10 = 35$.

Phonics / Spellings:

Children are in groups according to their phonic knowledge. Please support your child at home with their homework, which should be at their level, and spellings.

English:

This week we will be writing our information text all about gorillas. Your children are reminded to say their sentences out loud before they write them down. They should also be practicing their handwriting at home too.

Topic: This term in topic, we are learning about explorers and the world! This week we will learn about the oceans around us.

Science: In science this week, we will be looking at why animals are endangered and what we can do to help!
