

Messages:

Year 3 did it again! We won the points for best attendance. Well done! Please ask your child questions about the amazing work they have been doing in English. Please remember to wear Duncombe P.E kit to do P.E. The children need to read every day, and it is important that they are asked questions to check they understand what they are reading.

Maths:

The children will be beginning their new unit. We will be learning about addition and subtraction, using the formal column method to show our understanding. Most of the children in IN and some children in MF have been completing their Mathematics homework. It is important for the children to do their work as it will help them understand the lessons taught in school.

All the children must practise the timetables up to 12 and begin to learn the related division facts.

Phonics / Spellings:

The children will be looking at words ending in *-er*. These spellings are in their homework books so please encourage them to practice.

Children doing Read Write Inc will be bringing home a copy of their book every day. Please read this with them to help them with their phonics. This will help them with their Read Write Inc homework.

English:

Year 3 have been working incredibly hard on their writing this week, getting praise from all round the school. Reading our new book has been a lot of fun, ask the children to tell you about Supertatos adventures in White Hill Stores.

This week we're going to carry on writing about our brave hero Supertato, planning our descriptive writing and then writing an exciting description of settings and characters.

Topic:

After looking at atlases and globes, this week we're going to be focusing on one particular place, Shanghai in China.

After doing a virtual tour of the city, the children are going to be writing a postcard from Shanghai, sharing the sights and sounds of the "The Paris of East".

Homework:
