Maths:

This week Year 5 will be carrying on with our 'Multiplication and Division' unit; we will start the week looking at how to identify square and cube numbers, before moving on to multiplying by 10.

English:

Reading:

At the start of the week, the children will read Chapter 13 of Skellig. If they are working from home, they can watch the videos of it being read. The children will be summarising what has happened so far. They will also be thinking about what they have learnt about the characters in the book

Writing:

Year 5 will continue to draft a monologue from one character's point of view. Children will develop initial ideas, choose vocabulary for effect and use paragraphs to organise writing.

Talk Homework:

We are reading The Highway Man in English. Retell the story to someone at home. Who is your favourite character? Why? Who do you dislike? Why?
